

On to the world map project... basically the mural is based off a grid template (Map templates can be found online). We draw a very precise grid in pencil on the wall and draw a larger scale version of the map based on the template. We can make the map any size we want, as long as the length is two times the width. We need to use acrylic or latex house paint for a map that is 6' x 12' (pretty large!) You need 10 ounces of 8 paint colors, plus 2 quarts or more of ocean blue (which is a mix of $\frac{1}{2}$ quart of white with 3-5 teaspoonfuls of blue). The template should come with a color guide (how many teaspoonfuls to add to white) and what color to paint each country (so no colors are next to one another). You need to purchase:

- Brushes of various sizes
- Large erasers to erase grid lines
- Pencils
- Bowls to mix paint
- A meter stick to accurately draw the grid (a metal one works best as it will bend to fit in luggage)
- Cleanup items.
- 10 ounces of 8 different paint colors (Water based Acrylic or Latex house paint)
- 2 quarts of white paint
- Disposable gloves
- Large sponge to clean wall
